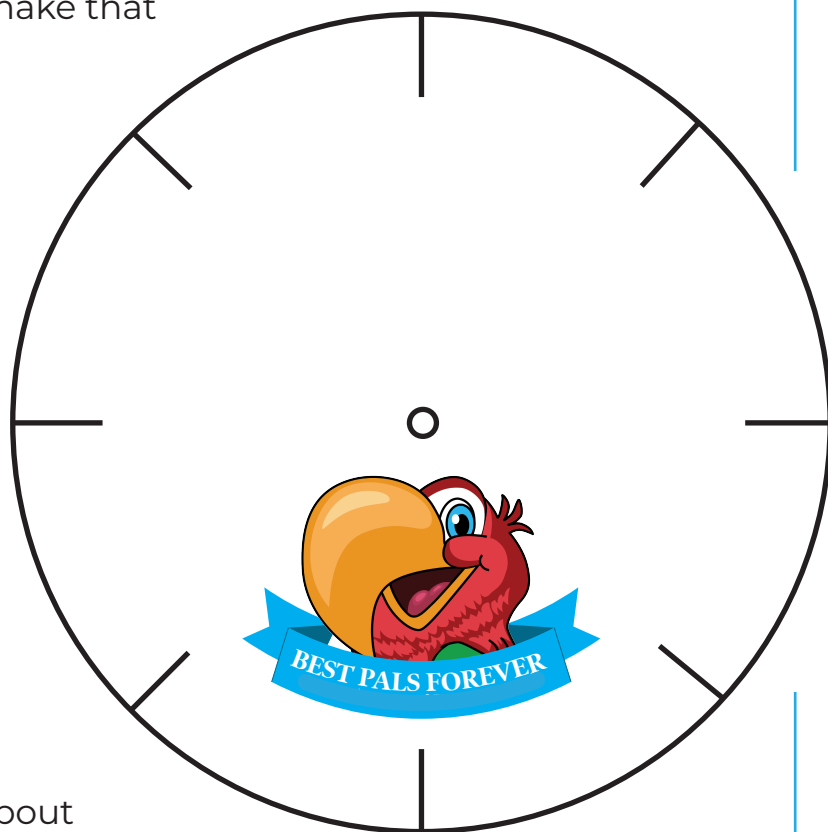
FRIENDSHIP BRACELETS

Is there someone extra special that you would like to make a friendship bracelet for? Today is your day! Follow these instructions and make that perfect gift for your friend.

WHAT YOU NEED:

A print out of these instructions
Scissors and a pencil
Embroidery Floss, various colors
A button

PACO'S TIP: Print out these instructions on cardstock paper for a nice sturdy bracelet wheel



WHAT TO DO:

1. Cut out the bracelet wheel with scissors, cutting 8 slits around the sides and poke a hole in the center with the pencil.
2. Cut 4 pieces of embroidery floss about 3-feet long each.
3. Fold the strands in half and tie a knot ~1-inch from the fold making a loop.
4. You now have 8 strands for your bracelet, but we only need 7. Cut off one of the strands with scissors close to the knot.
5. Insert your 7 bracelet strands through the center of the bracelet wheel and spread out your strands, place one strand in each slit. One slit will be empty.
6. Take the 3rd strand to the right of the empty slit, and move it to the empty spot.
7. Now take the 3rd strand to the right of the new empty slit and move it to the empty spot. Continue doing this. The bracelet will begin to form underneath the bracelet wheel. Continue until the bracelet is the desired length.
8. Take the bracelet off the wheel and tie the button to the end and cut off any additional embroidery floss.
